Houghton Transfer Station

Restricted Weekday Access

Last Week of July to Mid-December 2010

Due to Major Construction

Construction includes raising the station roof and other improvements at and adjacent to the facility that will improve safety and help reduce impacts on neighbors and the surrounding community.

Monday - Friday:

Station will be **CLOSED** to all customers except KCSWD Account Holders

On weekdays during construction, only King County Solid Waste Division account holders – those customers who have posted a bond and are billed by the Solid Waste Division – can use the station. All other customers will be redirected to other county solid waste facilities. *See below & back of flyer for other options.*

Saturday & Sunday:

Station open, but operating at limited capacity. **Expect delays & use caution!**

Recycling Services:

Recycling will be **CLOSED** on weekdays, but open on weekends.

1. Factoria Transfer Station 13800 SE 32nd St., Bellevue (7 miles south; 15 minutes)

Hours: Mon-Fri: 6:30 am – 4 pm, Sat-Sun: 8:30 am - 5:30 pm, Phone: 206-296-4466, TTY Relay: 711

Items accepted: Garbage. **No recycling services.** Household hazardous waste drop off service open
Tues-Fri: 8am-4pm, Sat & Sun: 9am-5pm

Directions to Factoria station:

1. Head west on NE 60th St.
2. Turn left on 116th Ave. NE
3. Turn right on Northup Way
4. Turn left on 116th Ave. NE
5. 116th Ave. NE becomes Lake Hills Connector
6. Take slight right onto Richards Rd SE
7. Turn left onto SE 32nd St.
8. Station is straight ahead

2. Renton Transfer Station 3021 NE 4th St., Renton (*15 miles south; 20 minutes*)

Hours: Mon-Fri: 7:30am - 5pm, Sat-Sun: 8:30am - 5:30pm, Phone: 206-296-4466, TTY Relay: 711

Items accepted: Garbage and recyclables (textiles, cardboard, mixed paper, newspaper, aluminum cans, tin cans, glass bottles & jars, plastic bottles, jars, tubs & jugs.)

Directions to Renton station:

1. Take I-405 South toward Renton
2. Take Exit 4 (Hwy 169 S / Renton / Enumclaw)
3. Turn left on NE 3rd St., which becomes NE 4th St.
4. Turn right on Jefferson Ave. NE; station is straight ahead

3. Shoreline Transfer Station 2300 N. 165th St., Shoreline (*14.5 miles northwest; 30 minutes*)

Hours: Mon-Fri: 7:30am - 5pm, Sat-Sun: 8:30am - 5:30pm Phone: 206-296-4466, TTY Relay: 711

Items accepted: Garbage, major appliances, yard waste, clean wood, scrap metal, CD, DVD and VCR players, cell phones, PDA's, 2-way radios, fluorescent bulbs & tubes, and recyclables (textiles, cardboard, mixed paper, newspaper, aluminum cans, tin cans, glass bottles & jars, plastic bottles, jars, tubs & jugs.)
