Special Recycling Collection at Carnation Bible Church

Saturday, June 8, 2013 9 AM to 3 PM (or until full)
King County Residents Welcome!

1. Sign-In

Please complete the recycling survey as you enter the event and drop off with the event staffers. Participants provide valuable information regarding recycling habits and how recycling could be improved in the Snoqualmie Valley, as well as the need for the event each year.

2. Clothing & Household Goods

Accepting re-usable clothing, shoes, linens, household goods, toys, radios, misc. Benefits Northwest Center. Tax receipts available.

- ◆ NO FURNITURE,
 - ◆ NO ITEMS NEEDING REPAIR.
- If not accepted, you must take it back.

3. Batteries

Car, truck, motorcycle, marine lead-acid batteries. Household batteries including: Size AA, AAA, B, C, D, button, and rechargeable.

4. Oil, Oil Filters & Antifreeze

- ◆ Used motor oil and oil filters. *Please bring oil in a reusable container like a plastic milk jug or daintainer. You must take the container with you.*
- ◆ Do not mix used oil with antifreeze, gasoline, solvents, kitty litter or other contaminants.
- ◆ Keep antifreeze separate.

5. CFL Bulbs & Fluorescent Tubes

Please handle with care. If the lamp or tube is not accepted, you must take it back.

6. Tires

Residential quantities only. We reserve the right to refuse commercial loads.

7. Major Appliances & Scrap Metal

Stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, microwaves, etc.


Scrap steel, auto parts, aluminum chairs, lawn mowers, microwaves, copper pipe. No containers that held chemicals or hazardous fluids. No glass in doors or windows. No fluorescent light fixture ballasts. No propane tanks or closed containers. Hot water tanks ok. Lawnmowers ok. No barbed wire.

8. Electronics & CFC Appliances-

TV's, monitors, CPU's, laptops, keyboards & mice, phones, DVD/VCR, printer, scanner, fax household copiers, stereos refrigerators/freezers - A/C units

ANY electronics working or not.

Layout of Collection Stations at Carnation Bible Church June 8th, 2013



1. Sign-in
2. Reusable household donations and clothes
3. Vehicle & household batteries
4. Used oil, oil filters, antifreeze
5. CFL bulbs & fluorescent tubes
6. Tires
7. Major appliances & scrap metal
8. Electronics

Please **pack your load in reverse order** according to the setup of collection stations shown on the map above. Load the materials for the higher-numbered stations into the front of your vehicle. This will make it easier to unload the low numbers first. Thanks!

*We reserve the right to refuse oversize, commercial, contaminated or unacceptable loads.
Please, no dump trucks or flat beds.*

Please DO NOT bring to Cleanup:

Garbage
Construction or Demolition Debris
Yardwaste or Wood Debris
Chemicals, paint or pesticides
