ORDINANCE NO. 687

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CARNATION, WASHINGTON AMENDING SECTION TWO OF ORDINANCE NO. 668 AND THE ADOPTED 2005 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR SUMMARY PUBLICATION.**

**WHEREAS**, due to unforeseen circumstances a need has arisen to amend the adopted 2005 budget of the City to reflect estimated actual expenditures which may vary from the total appropriations allocated in the 2005 adopted budget for certain funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council issued the 2005 Water & Sewer Revenue Bonds by Ordinance No. 676 in July 2005 to fund the 2005 Water System Improvement Project, the revenue and expense for which was not anticipated in the 2005 Budget as originally adopted; and

**WHEREAS**; some expenses for the ongoing maintenance and monitoring of the closed Carnation Landfill had been forecasted in the adopted 2005 budget for payment in 2004 but were not actually paid until 2005;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARNATION, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The totals of estimated revenues and expenditures for each of the following separate funds for the fiscal year 2005 annual budget, including beginning cash balances and undesignated ending fund balances, and the aggregate totals for all such funds combined are hereby amended as follows:

**Section 2.** A copy of this ordinance as adopted shall be transmitted to the Division of Municipal Corporations in the Office of the State auditor, and to the Association of Washington Cities.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and five (5) days following its publication by summary or posting as provided by law.
