RESOLUTION NO. 406

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARNATION, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE 2015 UPDATE TO THE COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE CITY OF CARNATION.

WHEREAS, the Revised Code of Washington 38.52.070 directs local jurisdictions to develop and maintain a local comprehensive emergency management plan; and

WHEREAS, local comprehensive emergency management plans establish the emergency management functions and responsibilities of the City and other public and private organizations that aid in the response and recovery from any hazard that could effect the city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Carnation first adopted a Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan by Resolution No. 314 in August 2006, which was subsequently updated in July 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City received notice in May 2015 from the Washington State Emergency Management Division (EMD) that another periodic update to the Carnation Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan was due by the end of December 2015; and

WHEREAS, a proposed update to the Carnation Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan was submitted to EMD for review and comment in December 2015; and

WHEREAS, the comments received from EMD in January 2016 have been addressed within the updated Carnation Comprehensive Emergency Plan attached to this resolution; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the updated Carnation Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan allows the City to remain current with the law and eligible for Emergency Management Performance Grant consideration; NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARNATION AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Plan Adoption. The updated Carnation Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan dated December 2015, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth, is hereby adopted as the comprehensive emergency management plan for the City of Carnation pursuant to RCW 38.52.070.


