RESOLUTION NO. 419

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARNATION, WASHINGTON, CERTIFYING THE BUDGET FOR THE 2018 PROPERTY TAX LEVY IN ACCORDANCE WITH RCW 84.52.020.

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 84.52.020 it is the duty of the City Council of the City of Carnation to certify to the King County Council the amount to be raised by taxation on the assessed valuation of property in the city; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 84.55.120 and Chapter 35A.33, the City Council held a public hearing on October 17, 2017, for the purpose of considering the 2018 Preliminary Budget and Revenue Sources, including possible increases in property taxes for the 2018 fiscal year; NOW THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARNATION, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Certification of 2018 Property Tax Levy.

A. The King County Assessor has notified the City Council of the City of Carnation that the estimated assessed valuation of all taxable property situated within the boundaries of the City of Carnation for assessment year 2017 and tax year 2018 is \$323,368,991.

B. In accordance with RCW 84.52.020, the City Council for the City of Carnation hereby certifies to the King County Council that the City of Carnation requests a property tax levy to be collected in 2018 in the amount of \$358,498, which was adopted following a public hearing held on October 17, 2017.

C. The County Comptroller of King County, Washington, is hereby authorized

and directed to deposit and sequester the monies received from the collection of the tax levy specified above in the amounts and funds specified below:

EXPENSE FUND:	<u>\$358,058</u>

TOTAL REGULAR LEVY:	<u>\$358,498</u>
EXCESS (VOTER APPROVED) LEVY:	\$ <u>0</u>

The above is a true and complete listing of the levies for the City of Carnation for tax year 2018 and they are within the maximums established by law.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by the City Council.


